Explanation of Ministries listed on the front side of this form.

01. Altar Server—sets up for Mass and assists the priest during Mass. Grade 6 and older
02. Art & Environment-- assists with decoration of Worship space
03. Assembly Representative—represents the general parish on the Worship Committee
04. Cantor—leads congregation in song at weekend liturgies and special services
05. Gift bearer—brings the gifts to the altar at weekend Masses—great family ministry
06. Greeter at Mass-welcomes mass goers as they enter church—great family ministry
07. Instrumentalist— musicians who play Guitar, Flute, Piano, Violin etc. to accompany the music at Mass
08. Lector—Weekend—proclaims the Word at weekend Masses
09. Lector—Weekday—proclaims the Word at daily Masses
10. Liturgy Preparation—works with a team to plan liturgical celebration
11. Minister of Eucharist—Weekend—distributes Holy Communion at weekend Masses
12. Minister of Eucharist—Weekday—distributes Holy Communion at daily Masses
13. Minister of Eucharist—Sick and Homebound—takes Holy Communion to shut-ins
14. Nursing Home Companion—assists residents at local nursing homes
15. Prayer Network—pray for specific prayer requests—great ministry for homebound members
16. Sacristy Guild—assists in cleaning the sacristy
17. Spirit Hand Bell Ringers Ensemble—ensemble of twelve ringers who play at liturgies
18. Spirit Singers—choir of teens and adults who sing at 10 am Mass and other liturgies
19. Spirit Youth Singers—Choir of children grades 2-8 who sing at most 10 am Masses
20. Usher—assists the congregation before and during Mass
21. Worship Committee—works with a team to develop meaningful worship services
22. Athletic Comm. Member—organizes and coordinate all sports activities—15 elected members/3 year term
23. Athletic Sports Coordinator—responsible for one specific sport, maintains daily operations
24. Bereavement Committee—gives support to families who have experienced the death of a loved one
25. Book Club—shares insights about books and engage in fellowship with other members
26. Brunch Bunch—an opportunity to meet other members around the brunch meal
27. Healing Blanket Ministry—volunteers create blankets which are blessed and given to babies and ill members
28. Hospitality Committee—provide a friendly and hospitable atmosphere while serving food at gatherings
29. Men's Group—gathers to allow men to focus on their spirituality
30. MOM's Group—gives Moms the opportunity to meet for discussion, support and bonding
31. Newsletter—writes, edits and/or does photography for quarterly newsletter about parish activities and members
32. Nominating Committee—identifies new and current members who have talents for various ministries
33. Nurses Networking—healthcare workers who engage in various outreach activities for the parish
34. Parish Life Committee—promote family life, community, and Christian fellowship
35. Parish Life Activity Planning Committee—plan community building activities for the parish
36. Scouts—adults who lead scout troops or youth who are members of the troops
37. Spirited Citizens—social, spiritual and service opportunities for members 55 and older
38. Stewardship Committee—promotes spirituality of stewardship (time, talent & treasure) throughout the parish
39. Supper Club—an opportunity to meet other members around the dinner meal
40. Welcome Committee—reach out to new members
41. Youth Ministries—work with youth grade 7 through college
42. Jr. Hi. Leadership Team—plans and oversees activities for youth grades 7 & 8
43. Jr. Hi Youth Group (JHYG)—gatherings for youth in grades 7 & 8
44. Hi. School Leadership Team—plans and oversees activities for High School youth
45. Hi. School Youth Group (HSYG)—gatherings for youth in High School
46. Angel Tree—ensure children in need are provided Christmas gifts (November & December)
47. Habitat for Humanity—groups of 12 who work construction on a house for a Habitat approved family
48. Respect Life—supports pro-life issues—abortion, euthanasia, death penalty et al
49. Social Concerns Committee—increase awareness of parish members to social issues
50. St. Vincent de Paul—assists those in need
51. Adult Enrichment Team—plans and implements formation programs for adults
52. ERE Teacher—Elementary Religious Education teacher for grades 1-8 on Wednesday evening
53. Lifelong Formation Committee—focuses on person spiritual growth for parish members
54. Scripture Study—two groups one meets on Sunday mornings and one on Wednesday mornings
55. Sunday Children's Church Leader—leads scripture reflections for children in K-grade 6
56. Sunday Nursery Volunteer—oversee and supervise children during the 10 am Mass
57. Sunday Preschool Volunteer— adults lead sessions for children ages 3-5 during the 10 am Mass
58. School Cafeteria Helper—assists in serving lunches and with cleaning up
59. School Clerical Helper—assists in performing clerical duties in the school
60. School Community Academic Competitions—adults to assist with preparing for and during competitions
61. School Parent/Parish Teacher Organization (PTO)—conducts programs for the benefit of the school

These are appointed positions. Interested volunteers will be interviewed and approved for appointment.

62. Budget Committee—responsible for preparing the annual budget for the parish
63. Charities Committee—advises the pastor on charitable contributions made from parish funds
64. Facilities Planning Committee—addresses the facility needs of the entire parish
65. Fr. McGee Student Aid Fund Comm—solicits and allocates funds for tuition assistance for Hi School students
66. Finance Council—assists the pastor in overseeing of financial and material concerns of the parish
67. Money Counters—counts the collection from the Masses
68. Properties Committee—address the long-term property needs of the parish
